Shaping the future of young people's TV programme:

- Date: Friday, 4 November 2023 (10-15 CET)
- **30 young people** on-site in Erfurt, Germany (same participants as of Summit)
- 10 commissioning editors of European TV channels on-site in Erfurt, Germany
- Workshop on how a new TV programme on the theme of European cinema can be developed
 - co-created and presented with and by young people
 - offered to the channels of the European Broadcasting Union (EBU)
 - exploring the adequate and modern format for such a TV magazine to engage young audiences with cinema

Young Audience Film Summit



Young people discuss around the theme *The Future of Humanity*:

- Date: Saturday, 4 November 2023 (10-15 CET)
- **30 young participants** from Europe on-site in Erfurt, Germany
 - Travel dates: 3 5 or 6 Nov. 2023
- 100 young participants online, handled by local partners
- Application to participate handled by European Film Club team
 - Online application form (link tba), timeline (tba)
- **Age** of the participants: 12-19 years
- Language: English
- Organised and run by the European Film Club Youth Council
- Screening fiction and documentary films
- Welcoming young campaigner guests
- **Exploring** climate change, human rights, societal impact of the pandemic (especially on young people's mental health) and in general utopian visions of the future through film

European Film Club Launch



Journey into European film:

- Date: Sunday, 5 November 2023
 - duration approximately 30 min
 - right before film screening
- European Film Academy will host an in-person cinema event in Brussels with members of the Youth Council attending
- Premiering a short film about the story of European Film Club
 - simultaneously in cinemas across Europe before film screening
- Welcoming young European audience via webcam
- Live connection to individual partners

Young Audience Film Day



Partner film screenings (1/2):

- Date: Sunday, 5 November 2023, approximate timing:
 - 13.00-14.30 Portugal
 - 14.00-15.30 Germany
 - 15.00-16.30 Romania
 - 16.00-17.30 Turkey
 - 17.00-18.30 Georgia
- **Age** of young audience 12-19 years
- Film screening of "highlight film" simultaneously
 - in cinemas all over Europe with local subtitles
 - online to European film clubs: watch party with English subtitles
- Film title organised by the Academy
 - Film file provided by the Academy (OV + Engl. subtitles)
 - Local translation / subtitles organised by local partners

Young Audience Film Day



Partner film screenings (2/2):

- Throughout day > window into all participating cinemas
 - Webcam tool hosted by Academy (eg. Zoom)
 - Creating a mosaic of all young audiences on large screen before/after screening
- Morning > free for local activities, eg. workshops (own choice)
- After screening > film discussion
 - in cinemas all over Europe (guided by local moderator)
 - online in European film clubs
- After screening > live Q&A with filmmakers and actors from Brussels
 - Academy provides tool for online participation
- European Film Club members will report from several locations around Europe
- European Film Club ambassadors (young European actors) will introduce screenings in several cities

European Young Audience Award



A category of the European Film Awards:

- Date: Sunday, 5 November 2023, evening (after screening)
- Announcement of the three nominated films for the EUROPEAN YOUNG AUDIENCE AWARD
- Trailer provided by the Academy
- 99 young people of all participants in the Young Audience
 Film Weekend will form the jury to vote for the winner film
 - Films will be provided online with English subtitles
 - Age of jury members 12-19 years, with a majority of 12-14 year-olds
 - Two jury members are invited to Berlin to announce the winner on stage of the European Film Awards Ceremony

- Local partner handle local participants
- Academy provides and moderates the virtual meeting lounge
